- Guarantee all year 3 and 5 students will meet National Minimum Standard in Reading
- Reduce the number of School Disciplinary Absences and increase attendance
- Continue to expand teacher capability in the teaching of reading, numeracy and across all Learning Areas

Our initiatives include

- Continuing to embed effective strategies for the teaching of reading across all learning areas by utilising feedback and establishing a case management approach
- Implementing a whole school approach to differentiated teaching and learning (intervention)
- Continuing to engage teachers in deepening their knowledge of the Australian Curriculum through understanding of marking guides, planning for differentiation and utilising pre and post moderation practices
- Implementing Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) to establish an inclusive, proactive approach to engaging students and improving behaviour and attendance

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Continue a Head of Curriculum position to support curriculum development and implementation throughout the school \$120 000
- Provide Teacher Relief Scheme for all teachers to support the development of curriculum planning, delivery and post moderation \$40 000
- Provide extra hours per week for nine current teacher aides to support students and teachers to implement a whole school approach to differentiated teaching and learning (intervention) \$35 000
- Purchase 0.1 staffing for the development and monitoring of ICP's \$10 000
- Purchase resources and access relevant professional development to ensure the successful implementation of PBL \$10 763
- Purchase 0.1 Speech Pathologist to support oral literacy in the early years \$9 000
